Blue Skies is based in the William Brinson Centre in Bow, London, and provides support to people who have a learning disability and/or associated mental health needs. The people who use our services range in age from 23-65 years of age.

Our diverse and experienced RCHL team have managed the Blue Skies service for over eight years.

Our current location is conveniently nearby to all key transport links into central London – Bow Road tube station, Bow Church D.L.R. and major bus routes are all within minutes from our base. Travel training is also available for those looking to become more independent. And for those whose health needs might not make this possible, we can organise our own transport for you.

Activities

We offer flexible, individual support according to your needs. The people who currently use Blue Skies have a wide range of support needs, ranging from one-to-one support, to those that need a minimum amount in order to maintain their independence.

Blue Skies consists of four separate groups within the service. Each has their own identity and is established from friendships, as well as some aspects of support needs.

We've also been working in partnership with Tower Hamlets Council and other 3rd party agencies for the last couple of years to develop our current service in line with the Government's 'Personalisation Agenda'.

The Blue Skies service currently operates Monday to Friday 9am–4pm all year round, excluding Bank Holidays and two staff training days a year.
